Town Council Appoints Multi-Use Building Committee

Members of the Multi-Use Building Committee were appointed Monday night by Kindersley Town Council at its February 22 regular meeting.

The 25-member committee will play a vital role in helping the Town of Kindersley determine the scope, use, and overall design of a future multi-use facility in the community. Membership within the committee includes representatives of Town Council, administration, and a cross-section of community, arts, culture, recreation, sports, and business interests. The committee also includes representation from the RM of Kindersley 290 and the Year 100 & Legacy Committee.

“We are very pleased to have strong representation from the overall community on this important Council-appointed Committee,” said Mayor Wayne Foster. “These individuals will help the Town plan a facility that will suit both the current and long-term needs of Kindersley residents and the region. Council spent a lot of time thinking about how to achieve a good cross-representation of community interests, while keeping the committee at a manageable number. We appreciate the many people who volunteered for the Committee, and hope that they stay engaged. Choices had to be made when appointing the Committee, but we will continue to make sure all interested citizens are consulted and that their voices are heard.”

The Multi-Use Building Committee has the power to make recommendations to Council for the design of the multi-use facility, fundraising and any other issues pertaining to the construction of this centre. The first meeting of the Committee will be held in early March.
