

BYLAW NO. 16-17

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KINDERSLEY TO AMEND BYLAW 04-14, KNOWN AS  
THE ZONING BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KINDERSLEY

The Council of the Town of Kindersley in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 04-14 as follows:

PART:

1. PURPOSE

Section 2 is amended by adding the following new definition immediately after the definition for "Public Work":

"**Railways and ancillary railway functions:** an area of land where trains are stored, switched, loaded or unloaded and includes sites and facilities used to transfer commodities, goods, or products from one mode of transportation to another including related offices and storage facilities."

2. COMING INTO FORCE

This Bylaw shall come into force and be in effect on the final reading thereof.




