The Project

Kindersley is embarking on a milestone initiative to construct a new indoor aquatic centre for the community and the West Central Saskatchewan Region. Replacing the 40-year former aquatic facility that has been closed since 2014, this project is the product of extensive community consultation efforts as well as fundraising initiatives.

Kindersley (population 4,571) is the largest community in west central Saskatchewan and the primary hub of the region serving a regional population of 20,000. It is a regional headquarters for oil and gas production, agriculture and a centre for recreation and culture events and programs.



Kindersley Town Council has committed to the construction of a new Indoor Aquatic Centre following an extensive public procurement process. The winning design-build consortium of Pro-Bilt Structures Ltd. and Western Recreation was selected for this \$6.6 million project. It is scheduled to be operational by fall 2018.

Funding

A project of this size is a significant undertaking for Kindersley, which like many communities across Canada, is subject to increasing budget restraints and demand for higher levels of service while maintaining reasonable taxation levels for citizens and businesses. The nearest comparable indoor aquatic facilities are in Saskatoon and North Battleford, both of which are two hours away.

A dedicated Pool Reserve was established to begin saving for the Aquatic Centre. To date \$1.1 million has been set aside for this project. Additionally, the Big Dippers Pool Fundraising Committee has generated \$100,000 through several successful fundraising events in 2016 and 2017.

Community and regional support for the Kindersley Aquatic Centre project is extremely high but we recognize the challenge in doing this on our own, without supportive funding from the Provincial and Federal Governments. Corporate sponsorship is an essential component to making this west central Saskatchewan dream a reality and we are confident that your organization sees the tremendous value in being associated with the Kindersley Aquatic Centre project.
