Loraas Environmental Services is pleased to introduce our automated waste collection system. Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the enclosed instructions and hints.

Many other communities have adopted our automated waste collection system and the results have produced a cleaner, more attractive environment. Wind blown litter and animal scavenging is completely eliminated with this system.

The cart provided was chosen for its durability and its ease of use. It holds three times as much as a normal trash can. The cart's large wheels make it easy to manoeuvre, and it completely eliminates the lifting of heavy cans.

Help us keep our community clean by bagging all trash to minimize windblown litter.

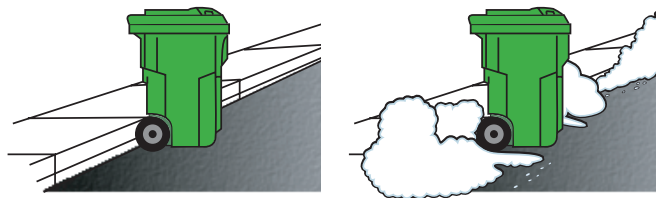

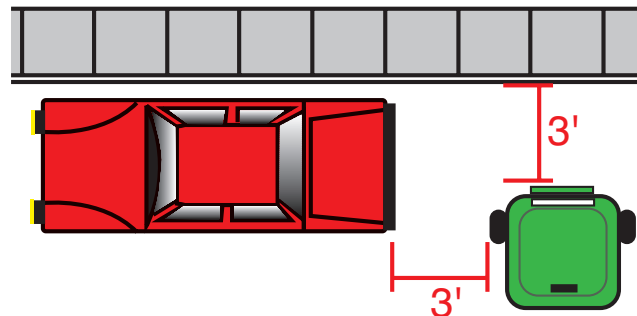
General Guidelines

- Cart lids must be completely closed for prevention of windblown materials. Over-filled carts with open lids may not be emptied.
- Place your cart as shown in the diagram by 7:00 am on collection day - this includes all statutory holidays, **EXCEPT** Christmas Day and New Year's Day.
- All trash must be bagged and placed inside of your black cart. Any trash left beside the cart will not be collected.
- Please return your cart to your property before the end of the collection day.
- In the event of severe weather, please leave your cart curbside. Our trucks will provide service as soon as possible after conditions have cleared.
- Do not remove your cart from its assigned address.
- Do not paint or mark your cart.
- Please do not allow children to play in or near the collection containers or vehicles.
- Inform your city, town or village office or Loraas Environmental Services of any damage, vandalism or theft of the cart. It is important to note the serial number stamped on the cart placed at your residence.
- Please check with your Municipal office for information on your local recycle or compost options.

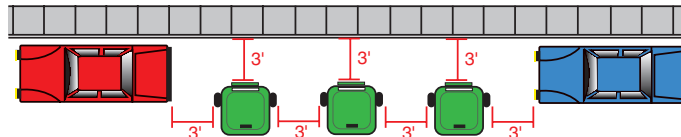
Ideal Location #1 Snow Bank #2



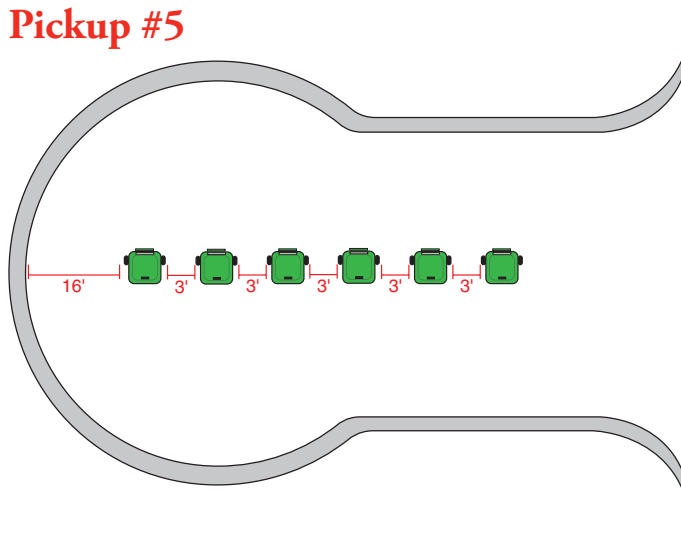
Close to a Parked Car or Other Obstructions #3

Prohibited Items

We are permitted to accept only solid, non-hazardous waste materials including general garbage, food, yard and garden waste, etc. We do not accept regulated waste such as:



Hazardous Waste



Medical Waste



Pressure Filled Containers



Paint



Used Oil or Containers



Electronics

Other items unsuitable for your cart:

- Sod, dirt, or tree clippings over 2 feet in length
- Ashes of any kind
- Construction or demolition materials including concrete, boards, roofing materials, carpet, etc.
- Automotive parts, oil filters, batteries, tires, etc.
- Liquids of any kind
- Animals or animal parts
