








Colour the hot things red and the cold things blue. Help your child find other hot and cold things in the house.







# **Important Things to Remember**


Fires can be loud, burn very fast, and smoke can make a room very dark.

That's why good escape plans help you get out quickly.

Here's how to help your family with an escape plan.


- <u>н</u> Try to find at least two ways out from every room in your home.
- 2 Every way needs to be planned and practised with grown-ups.
- 3. Remember to stay low and go.
- ÷ Before opening a door in a fire, feel it first. If it's hot, there may be fire on the other side. Do not open the door. Try to get out another way.
- ပာ Pick an easy-to-remember, safe place outside to meet your family after you get out.
- 6. Call 9-1-1 or the emergency number from a neighbour's place.
- 7. Stay outside no matter what. Don't go back in for anything!


