Surveying

- Performing quantity surveys for various construction activities.
- Assist in staking out construction projects.
- Assist in preforming leveling loops using a rod and level.
- Collecting preliminary survey data using a Trimble GPS unit.

Data Collection

- Performing visual inspections of paved and concrete surfaces.
- Creating and updating various asset management documents.
- Documenting and verifying the Town's asset registry.

QUALIFICATIONS and REQUIRMENTS:

- Valid Driver's License.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and Outlook.
- Experience using Trimble Surveying Equipment would be considered an asset.
- Experience using AutoCAD & Civil3D.
- Familiar with material testing procedures.
- Accuracy with details and excellent written and verbal communications.
