Due to concerns brought up from Kindersley officials and schools; we implemented a program where almost everyday an officer will be at your local schools in morning and afternoon for traffic safety. This is due to complaints of vehicles doing illegal u turns, speeding, stop sign (bus) violations. We gave out three warnings to parents who drove though stop signs and sent newsletters from school to inform parents of proper procedures and that we would be there. After news report next week infractions will be given if noted.
